Locogen were approached in early 2011 by Ingliston Country Club, who required expert advice on the best renewable energy solution to reduce their carbon footprint and provide a solid financial investment for the club.

Locogen's initial assessments found a 120kWp solar PV installation would be best suited to the location. Locogen then provided a complete consultancy service to the club and oversaw the project from start to finish.

The necessary consents were secured before a bespoke design stage which matched the planned installation to the characteristics of the site and available roof space.

The finished system consists of 542 solar PV modules installed over two roofs. The solar panels are connected to the grid using Fronius inverters.

The PV array was installed in four weeks and was the largest in Scotland when commissioned in July 2011.

Locogen accredited the scheme with Ofgem just before a major change in the government's Feed-in Tariff incentive, allowing the club to benefit from 20 years' guaranteed income at a highly favourable rate.
