WIND PRINCES GATE SPRING WATER





Princes Gate Spring Water Ltd is situated on an organic farm in Pembrokeshire, South Wales. Twenty years ago the farm owners started selling bottled spring water from the site and the company has grown to be one of the largest sellers of bottled water in the UK.

Locogen were commissioned through Carbon Trust Wales to investigate the potential for a medium-scale wind energy project at the site to offset the company's significant electricity demand. Different scales of turbine were considered, the preferred option being a development of two 500kW turbines.

Following completion of screening and scoping works with all project stakeholders, Locogen managed the full planning procedure, involving detailed environmental assessments. These included a noise monitoring survey and associated modelling, a full landscape and visual impact assessment, archaeology surveys, cumulative impact assessments, ecological surveys and transport studies.

As planning progressed Locogen also managed an in-depth wind monitoring programme, leasing a 50m monitoring mast to ensure the available wind resource was well understood.

Locogen also undertook the necessary grid works for the turbines to ensure the most cost-effective connection solution was secured.

Finally, Locogen project-managed the procurement, contractual and construction process. Work began onsite in late 2013; the two Enercon E53 turbines were commissioned and began operation in spring 2014.
