Prestige Leisure supply branded clothing to printers and embroiderers for use in the leisurewear and workwear sectors. Founded in 1992, they operate from headquarters in West Lothian, which boast a 100,000 square foot distribution facility holding more than 1.5 million stock items.

The environmentally-focused company had already progressed with rainwater harvesting and electric vehicles at the site, but were also keen to look at renewable energy as a way to offset their substantial electricity costs and further boost their environmental credentials.

Locogen carried out a detailed site survey and analysed the property's energy use, and suggested that a 250kWp solar PV system would be the best option in terms of maximising onsite usage, carbon saving and revenue generation from the Feed-in Tariff (FiT).

Locogen then secured the relevant planning, grid connection and building warrant consents, before completing the construction and commissioning of the system on one of the warehouses at the site. This included the installation of a new electricity supply to the warehouse, to conduct the electricity to the main factory building where it is used.

The system benefits from 960 high-performance REC 260W panels and market-leading ABB inverters. A remote monitoring system has also been installed and Locogen regularly check the performance of the PV array to ensure there are no faults in its operation.
